This is not a coupon code at checkout, but a passcode that makes a "hidden" session available. This code only applies to the first week of 7/11 camp. It will also help us (Macedonia) know who is attending camp from our campus.

If using the code macedonia711, please only pay the \$100 deposit. We will do some fundraising to lower your final cost. Final payment is not due until later in the year. Last year we were able to supplement about 50% of the total cost for camp (\$360). We will try our best to do the same this year.

What is Power Day Kids Camp?
